Bedwas Tips Reclamation - Amendments to draft Transport Statement

The following cover letter has been written to outline changes made to the draft Transport Statement submitted as part of the Pre-Application Consultation (PAC) process. These include:

- An error was made which has been noted originally stating “*approximately 60 HGVs per day over 10 weeks*”. This has been corrected to now state “*approximately 60 HGVs over four months*”. It is also acknowledged that the paragraph numbering was missing from the document and as such as also been updated. Apologies for any confusion which has been caused by this statement over the consultation process.

Specific reference changes are outlined below:

Section 6.1 – “ <i>An increase in traffic flow of 60 HGVs per day over 10 weeks bringing in plant and equipment during the construction phase is considered negligible with access provided from the A467 which is part of the strategic highway network.</i> ”	Paragraph 6.1.3 – “ <i>An increase in traffic flow of approximately 60 HGVs over four months bringing in plant and equipment during the construction phase is considered negligible with access provided from the A467 which is part of the strategic highway network.</i> ”
